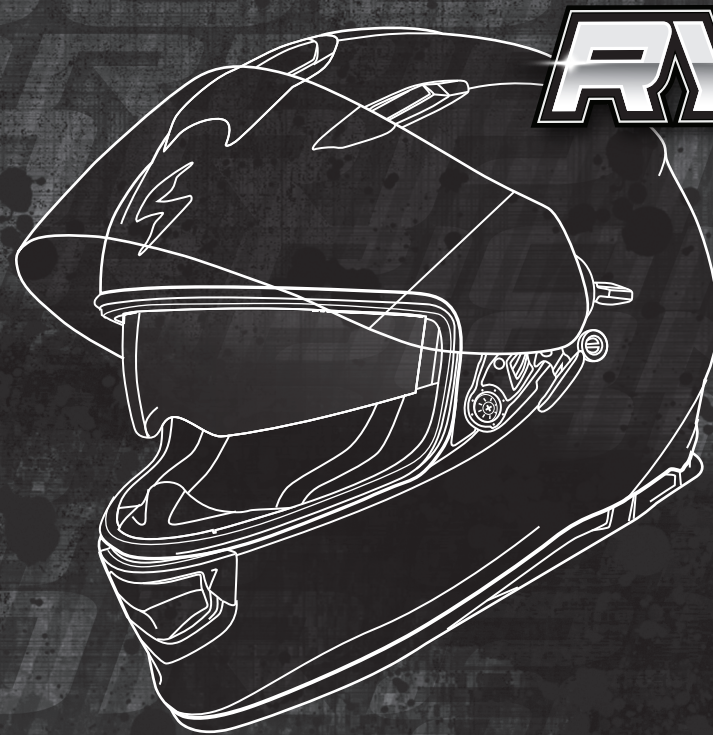

## FEATURE SUMMARY

### 1 SPEEDVIEW® RETRACTABLE INTERNAL SUNVISOR

The retractable internal sun visor protects the rider from excessive sunlight, dirt, and small flying objects. It is optically clear and features a state of the art fog-free technology, a anti-scratch hardened coating, and UV protection.

### 2 PINLOCK® PREPARED FACESHIELD

The shield is with Anti-Scratch hardened coating, and is ready for Pinlock® max vision system, the world's best fog free resistant system.

### 3 KWIKWICK® C LINER FABRIC

The removable and washable liner features a soft and supple hypo-allergenic, anti-bacterial material with advanced moisture wicking properties.

### 4 ELLIP-TEC® RATCHET SYSTEM

Easy, Secure, tool-less faceshield changes in seconds. Pulls the shield back against the eyepoint gasket during closing to ensure a proper seal.

### 5 AERO-TUNED VENTILATION

Four intake ports including a 2-step mouth vent across the front of helmet forces cool air in and maximizes the movement of hot air out through rear vent.

### 6 FACESHIELD LOCK

Integrated shield locking system securely locks shield in place sealing out the elements.

### 7 SPEAKER POCKETS

Speaker ducts designed into the EPS allow compatibility with communication unit speakers up to 50mm.

### 8 EMERGENCY RELEASE SYSTEM

Tabs located under the neck roll allow easy removal of the cheek pads by emergency medical personnel thus allowing easier removal of the helmet.

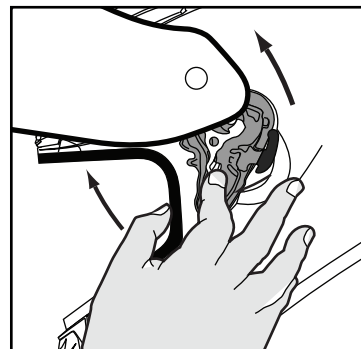

## FACE SHIELD REPLACEMENT



**IMPORTANT NOTE:** Be sure to latch up the "Y" release latchet while removing the faceshield!

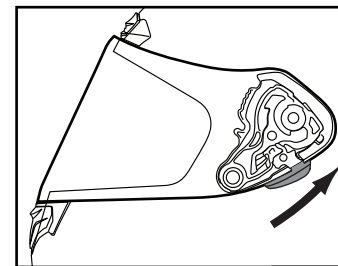
### » REMOVE FACE SHIELD

First place the helmet in front of you with the eye port facing away. Ratchet the faceshield up to the fully open position. Using both hands, push up the Y shape release latchet upward and the shield is able to release out of locking mechanism. Then, with both of your thumbs pushing squarely on the center of the Ellip-Tec™, gently pull or "peel" the faceshield away from the helmet.

**NOTE:** THE FACESHIELD CAN ONLY BE REMOVED OR INSTALLED WHEN IN FULLY OPENED POSITION

## FACE SHIELD LOCK/LEVER

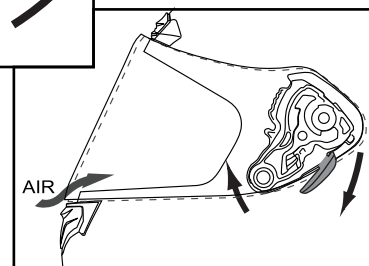


### » LOCK FACE SHIELD

Turn Locking-lever counter clockwise to the 2 o'clock position approximately. Check face shield if its securely locked.

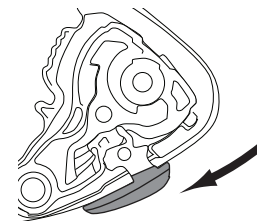
### » UNLOCK FACE SHIELD

To unlock the face shield, and provide air flow at low speeds, turn Locking-lever clockwise to the 7 o'clock position. Test faceshield to check if it is unlocked



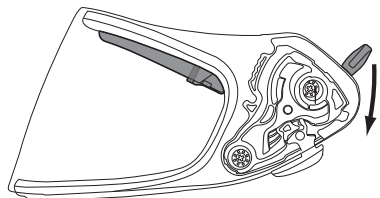
### ⚠ NOTE ⚠

FIRST, CLOSE SHIELD TO THE LOWEST POSITION TO LOCK/UNLOCK

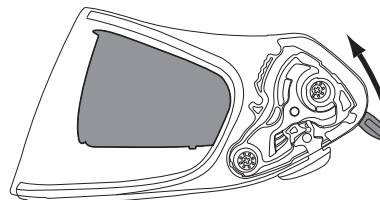

## » SUN VISOR OPERATION



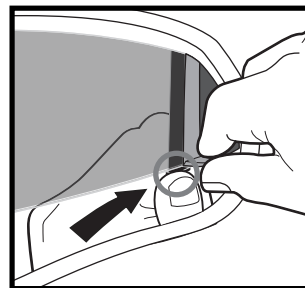
TO LOWER THE INNER SUN VISOR, SIMPLY PULL THE SPEEDVIEW® RETRACTION-LEVER DOWN.



TO RAISE THE SUN VISOR, JUST PUSH THE SPEEDVIEW® RETRACTION-LEVER UP.

**NOTE:** THE RETRACTABLE INTERNAL SUNVISOR CAN BE LOWERED AND RETRACTED, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER OR NOT THE FACESHIELD IS UP OR DOWN.

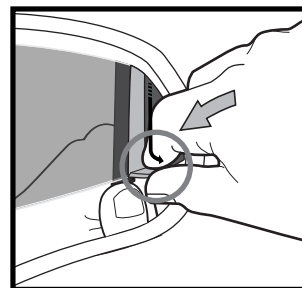
## » SUN VISOR REMOVAL



PUSH THE STOPPER TO RELEASE

**NOTE:** For easier Sun Visor removal: First, remove the outer faceshield.

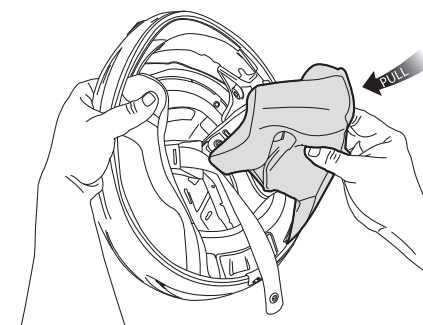
Hold the sun visor with your left hand. Gently push the stopper in to release.



PULL SIDE BRACKET TO DISJOINT

Gently, pry apart the side bracket by pulling the arm towards you to disjoint the bracket from the sun visor. Then release the shield from the clasp, pulling downwards slightly. With one side now disjointed, pry apart the other side to completely detach the sun visor.

Reverse process for installation.



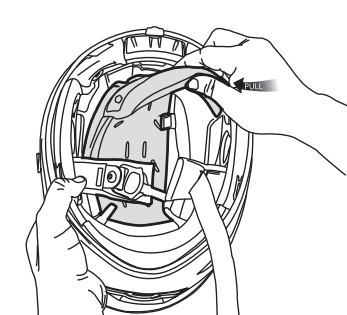
## » CHEEK PADS REMOVAL

Occasionally the cheek pads may require removal for washing or replacement.

1. Remove the Aero Skirt.
2. Slide your thumb between the cheek pad and chin bar, gently tug. Once both cheek pads are removed you can also remove the crown liner component.
3. Gently pull cheek pad away from inner chin bar to unsnap plastic clips.

Repeat this process for both cheek pads. Once both cheek pads are removed you can also remove the crown liner component.

Reverse this process for installation.

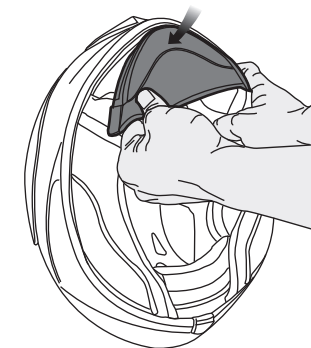


## » CROWN LINER REMOVAL

Occasionally the crown liner may require removal for washing, replacement or to change sizes.

1. Remove the cheek pads.
2. At the back of the helmet pull the crown liner away from the shell unsnapping the two snaps.
3. Pull the crown liner out of the helmet while gently detaching it from the forehead channel.

Reverse this process for installation.



## » AERO SKIRT REMOVAL

The pliable Aero Skirt was designed to reduce wind from entering behind the face shield area, specifically to keep your face warmer in cold weather.

You do however have the option to remove the Aero Skirt for cleaning or for warmer riding conditions.

### TO REMOVE

Simply tug on the Aero Skirt and it slides out of the rubber trim channel.

Reverse this process to re-install.
